**SEARCH WARRANT**

**IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK TO ANY  
POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE BUFFALO POLICE DEPARTMENT,  
STATE OF NEW YORK, UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, AND ANY  
POLICE OFFICER ACTING UNDER THEIR DIRECTION.**

Proof by Affidavit having been made this day before me by Detective Anna Mydlarz, a Police Officer, with the Buffalo Police Department, that there is reasonable cause to believe that computer hardware, computer software, and computer related documentation, which constitutes evidence that the crimes of Aggravated Harassment, in violation of Penal Law Sections 240.31-1 have been and are being committed, and that such evidence may be found in the residence of 578 Breckenridge Street, Buffalo, New York, County of Erie, State of New York. The residence is described as a 2 ½ story wood frame, cedar shake, painted yellow with green trim around the windows and roof line and an enclosed front porch. The house is located on the North side of Breckenridge just east of Norwood. There is an adjacent apartment attached to this residence which is a separate dwelling number 180 Breckenridge. There are three (3) satellite dishes above the front entrance to 578 Breckenridge. The front of the residence is surrounded by a metal chain link fence with gate. The number "578" are in black on the left side and right

side of the front entry door attached to the house. The residence is across the street from 579 Breckenridge Street, Buffalo, NY.

**YOU ARE THEREFORE COMMANDED**, within ten (10) days of the date of the issuance of this warrant, in the daytime, to make a search of a residence commonly know as 578 Breckenridge Street, Buffalo, New York, County of Erie, State of New York and seize the following property:


1. Property which constitutes evidence of and tends to demonstrate that these offenses were committed, including, transactional information and emails relating to the creation, possession and distribution of the false press releases, and
2. Computer hardware, that is, all equipment which can collect, analyze, create, display, convert, store, conceal, or transmit electronic, magnetic, optical, or similar computer impulses or data. Hardware includes (but is not limited to) any data-processing devices (such as central processing units, memory typewriters, and self-contained "laptop" or "notebook" computers); internal and peripheral storage devices such as computer disks, magnetic media-floppy disks, tape systems, hard drives, disk drives, tape drives, transistor-like binary devices, and other memory storage devices; and any external attachments peripheral input/output devices such as keyboards, printers, scanners, plotters, video display monitors, and optical readers; and related communications devices such as modems, cables and connections, recording equipment, RAM or ROM units, acoustic couplers, automatic dialers, speed dialers, programmable telephone dialing or signaling devices, and electronic tone-generating devices; as well as any devices, mechanisms, or parts that can be used to restrict access to computer hardware (such as physical keys and locks).

3. Computer software, that is, digital information which can be interpreted by a computer and any of its related components, which may be stored in electronic, magnetic, optical, or other digital form. It commonly includes programs to run operating systems, applications (such as word-processing, graphics , or spreadsheet programs), utilities, compilers, interpreters, and communications programs; computer related documentation, that is, written, recorded, printed, or electronically stored material which explains or illustrates how to configure or use computer hardware, software, or other related items.

YOU ARE FURTHER COMMANDED and authorized to enter said premises without giving notice of your authority and purpose pursuant to Section 690.35 of the CPL.

YOU ARE FURTHER COMMANDED to enter said premises and, if you find the same or any part thereof of the described property, and if you seize any of the described property, to bring it forthwith before me at this issuing court.
